How to end it?

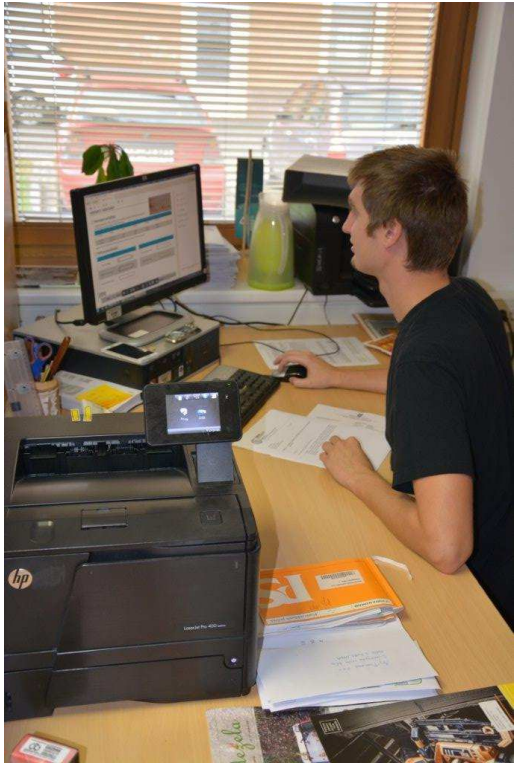
I can say only this: you are young and successful, go abroad, travel and meet new people.
